SHEEP SECTION RULES

- 1. All female sheep in the Cheviot & Blackface sections must be maintained and shown from exhibitors own hill hirsel.
- 2. In classes 1, 11 & 25 tup must have been used once on the exhibitors hirsel.
- 3. In classes 5, 14, 17, 21 & 29 ewe must have nursed until 1st August.
- 4. In classes 4, 10, 20, 28 & 34 sheep must have competed in other classes.
- 5. All 1st Prize winners, including sheep from a pair, are eligible for the Championship.
- 6. In Class 35 lambs must be the offspring of any recognised hill breed.
- 7. Sheep may be shown in one class only (except when shown in a group class).
- 8. Bought in sheep allowed.
- 9. In overall junior section all competitors to be under 25.
- 10. If entries in classes 17 to 24a are low, these sections may be amalgamated.

INDUSTRIAL SECTION RULES

- All entries in Industrial Sections must be the exhibitors own work, except class
 75 which must be the property of the owner.
- 2. Exhibits to be benched by 10am, judging to commence at 10.30am.

Shortbread Biscuits

Ingredients

2oz Butter (slightly softened – 8 seconds in microwave) 2oz Margarine 2oz Caster Sugar 2oz Cornflour or Rice flour 4oz Plain Flour

Some Caster Sugar for dusting

Method

Place all in one bowl, rub together, turn out onto floured surface and knead together till smooth, roll out to about ¼ inch thick and cut into biscuits (your choice of shape), place on baking sheet, bake in preheated oven 160c until golden brown for about 15 to 20 mins. (time depending on your oven as they do vary), dust with caster sugar.
