SHEEP SECTION RULES

1. All female sheep in the Cheviot & Blackface sections must be maintained and shown from exhibitor's own hill hirsels.
2. In classes 1, 11 and 28 tup must have been used at least once on the exhibitor's hirsels.
3. In classes 5, 14, 20, 23, & 32 ewe must have nursed until 1st August.
4. In classes 4, 10, 17, 31 & 37 sheep must have competed in other classes.
5. All 1st Prize winners, including sheep from a pair, are eligible for the Championship.
6. In class 38 lambs must be the offspring of any recognised hill breed.
7. Sheep may be shown in one class only (except when shown in a group class).
8. Bought-in sheep allowed.
9. In overall junior section all competitors to be under 25.
10. If entries in classes 18 to 27 are low, these sections may be amalgamated.

INDUSTRIAL SECTION RULES

1. All entries in Industrial Sections must be the exhibitor's own work, except class 102 (soap dish) which must be the property of the owner.
2. Exhibits to be benched by 10am, judging to commence at 10.30am.
3. **ANY PREVIOUS PRIZE WINNING ARTICLE AT THIS SHOW CANNOT BE RE-SHOWN.**
4. Exhibitors are responsible for staging their own exhibits. The committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibits during or after the show, although they will receive all possible care and attention.
5. Prize money will be paid out at Industrial Tent after 3pm
6. Exhibits to be uplifted after prizegiving.

Oatcakes

Ingredients

1 cup Oatmeal
Pinch Bicarbonate of Soda
1 teaspoon melted Fat or Dripping
¼ teaspoon Salt
Hot Water to Mix

Method

Mix dry ingredients and add fat. Add sufficient water to make a moderately stiff Dough. Roll out as thin as possible. Cut into shapes and bake in moderate oven.
